## SEPTEMBER

\*\*All payments are still due during holiday closures with no reductions. Vacation credits cannot be used for these closures. Snow days and emergency closures such as power outages, pandemics and storms can occur as well and are billable days. We offer one half price vacation week per school year (Sept to August). A vacation credit can only be applied after you have been registered for 3 months. Your account must also be in good standing. Your child must be out for the entire week that the vacation is applied to. The front desk must be notified in advance. We can no longer provide make-up days for illnesses or holiday closures. Your child must be out of the building for the whole week to apply for the vacation credit. The only week it cannot be used is when we are closed during the christmas/New years break.

- **For monthly payers:** take your monthly Tuition and divide by 3.4, to get your weekly price, then divide by 2 to get your discount amount for your ½ price credit that will be deducted from your monthly tuition.
- **Weekly Payers:** ½ off your weekly tuition.

I understand the schedule of closures and that I must pay my usual tuition if my child is sick or there is a school holiday/closure.
